This specialist training day is one of five leading to a Wealden Institute 'Introductory Certificate in Animal Assisted Therapy.

This training will take place entirely at College Farm, and will explore the use of animals in therapeutic work. Participants will work alongside the Institute's animals during experiential exercises. The training will cover the theory and practice of animal assisted therapy and its widespread use with a range of clients.

Each Animal Assisted Therapy day will address a different aspect of TA theory in the context of working with animals when helping people therapeutically

Please note that the training takes place on a working farm. Please come prepared for outdoor activities and exercises, with weather-appropriate clothing, in particular rubber boots or similar footwear.
