Working with Couples using a Systemic Approach

Sunday 22 April 2018 (9.30 to 4.30)

In this workshop Diane will share the theory and practice of how she works with couples adopting a systemic approach. Various aspects of TA theory will be examined in order to understand the couple's relationship in system terms, and also the therapists place within that system. The Comparative Script System, Interlocking Racket Systems and Symbiosis will be developed as tools for both diagnosis and treatment planning.

Some aspects of Family Constellation work with couples will also be explored. While Diane will offer theoretical input, the workshop will also be largely experiential and participants are invited to bring their own work with couples for supervision. There will be opportunities to role play either therapist or client in skills development practice.
