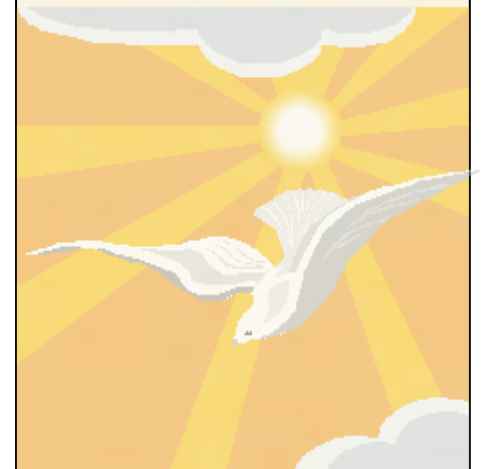

**Training in Trauma  
Therapy  
Introductory Certificate  
&  
Diploma**

**Wealden Psychology Institute was founded in Crowborough in 1986 by Joanna Beazley Richards and has continued to develop since that time as a centre for excellence in the fields of Psychology, Counselling and Psychotherapy.**

**Wealden Trauma Clinic** was officially opened in 2008, and has a team of therapists dedicated to the treatment of people suffering from the adverse effects of traumatic events. We offer EMDR, CBT and Integrative Trauma Therapy.

The Trauma Training developed and delivered by Joanna Beazley Richards leads to an **Introductory Certificate in Trauma Therapy** as a pre-requisite for the **Diploma in Trauma Therapy**. These courses are for trained counsellors or psychotherapists.

To obtain the Introductory Certificate in Trauma Therapy, participants must have completed at least one year of training in counselling and psychotherapy, and have attended:

- 1) Trauma and Recovery (one day workshop; to be attended as the first day), followed by, in any order:
- 2) Attachment, Attachment Disorder workshop, (two days);
- 3) Trauma in Children workshop (one day);
- 4) Severe and Complex Trauma workshop (one day).

Note that after the basic first day, the other three workshops may be attended in any order.

Total 30 hours training.

In addition to attendance at the above workshops, participants are required to complete a learning log of the five days, plus a brief critique of 'Trauma and Recovery' by Judith Lewis Herman (2001) Pandora, London. They must also read 'The Body Remembers' by Babette Rothschild (2000) Norton, New York and 'The Body Keeps the Score' by Bessel Van der Kolk (2014) Allen Lane, London.

#### **Fees:**

#### **Introductory Certificate in Trauma Therapy**

The fees for each of the five introductory level workshops are £105 per day.

#### **Diploma in Trauma Therapy**

€775 includes:

- Five training days at Wealden Institute (France)
- Lunch each day
- Marking written work and admin costs.

€200 one-off additional bed and breakfast fee, payable in cash on arrival for those choosing to stay on site for the five days (note that the Centre will open on the first day of the course and close on the last).

#### **To obtain the Diploma, participants must:**

- Successfully complete the Introductory Certificate in Trauma Therapy.
- Attend the full training programme.
- Complete the written work which includes a learning log and an essay of 15000 words.
